Where history beckons



Baghera

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Step into the village Baghera and you enter the bygone era. The 17th century fortress and 10th century temple is a rendezvous with the glorious history of this small village. Let religion take over in the Jain temples in the village and the Shiva temple. The Bisalpur dam is 14 km from this village.

What to look around for?

Watch out for the remnants from the ancient history spread all around the village Baghera — 10th century temple, cenotaphs, cave and many more. Let your shopping buds feast as you shop for the local handicrafts like carpets and leather crafts.

What not to miss?

The 17th century fort Baghera is something you can't afford to miss. Built with heavy stone blocks and surrounded by two massive ramparts with round Burjs on the four corners, the fortress is also surrounded by a moat.

The annual cattle fair in the month of February-March among other fairs and festivals like Holi, Diwali, Gangaur, etc are sure to take you close to the Rajasthani culture.

Where to stay?

Comfortable accommodation options with good amenities are available in the nearby cities.

How can I get there?

Baghera is well connected to Ajmer, Nasirabad, Jaipur and other major cities across Rajasthan by road.

How far is the closest city (with accommodation facility)?

- Kekri - 18 km
- Nasirabad - 73 km
- Ajmer - 100 km
- Jaipur (nearest airport) - 232 km
