Situated 30 km from the Ranthambhor National Park Gate, Bhoori Pahari is where you should go for an exciting experience of adventure and rural culture.

What not to miss?

While you explore Bhoori Pahari, don't miss the opportunity to interact with the local folks and be part of their evening gatherings. Look into the way of life of the local Meena tribals, known for their exquisite attire and ornaments.

What to look around for?

Bhoori Pahari is the place for those who seek adventure, from horse & camel safaris on white sand plains, trekking in mountainous areas, to boating and bird-watching for nature lovers. The village is situated on the confluence of Banas and Morel rivers and is in close proximity to adventure getaways.

Where to stay?

You can opt for

- A home stay
- Camping at designated camping sites
- Farm houses

How can I get there?

Bhoori Pahari is well connected to Jaipur and other major cities across Rajasthan by road.

How far is the closest city (with accommodation facility)?

- Ranthambhor - 35 km
- Sawai Madhopur (District Headquarters) - 40 km
- Dausa - 145 km
- Jaipur via Dausa (nearest airport) - 205 km
