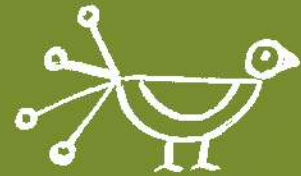

Nestled in the lap of Aravali Hills, Bichun is where you will discover the skill of making lovely mojaris (Rajasthani footwear), aari taari (embroidery), pottery and colourful bangles. The village is home to artisans who have inherited the talent of craftsmanship from time unknown.

The people of the Village are strongly rooted to their customs and culture. Their life, away from the jostling urban routine, is what you experience and become a part of.

What not to miss?

When in Bichun, make sure that you try your hand at pottery making. For that, you can pick up some basic skills from potters, who will readily guide you through your 'experiment'. Apart from that, stop by at the homes of shoe makers and traditional sari designers to get the best pieces right there, at a good price.

What to look around for?

Solicit blessings at the Grand Temple of Saint Dadu Dayal, which lies 8 km away from the village.

Where to stay?

You can opt for

- A home stay
- Camping at designated camping sites

How can I get there?

Bichun is well connected to Jaipur by road. It is 10 km off the Jaipur-Ajmer Express Highway from village Mokhampura (40 km from Jaipur).

How far is the closest city (with accommodation facility)?

- Jaipur (nearest airport) - 45 km
- Ajmer - 90 km
- Delhi - 304 km
