Khabha is a village close to Jaisalmer, more than half of which is completely deserted. The grazing cattle and peacocks lead you to the Khabha fort which has recently been renovated.

## What to look around for?

The ancient fort in the Khabha village takes you to the depths of rich history of the village. The fort houses a Geological Museum which exhibits fossils. The ruins of the houses, deserted for over 250 years, are simply astonishing.

## What not to miss?

Join the cattle farmer as he starts his day with taking cattle to feed; womenfolk milking cows, goats, sheep, camels and preparing their bread on earthen stove.

## Where to stay?

You can opt for

- Camp in the rural setting
- Tents / Huts in Sam Sand Dunes resorts / hotels (5 km)

## How can I get there?

The village is well connected to Jaisalmer.

## How far is the closest city (with accommodation facility)?

- Jaisalmer - 35 km
- Jodhpur (nearest airport) - 335 km
